

V. Lift up your hearts. R. We lift them up to the Lord.




V. Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. R. It is right and just.




It is truly right and just, our duty and our sal-va-tion, al-ways and

and Paul bring us joy: Peter, foremost in con-fess-ing the faith,




Paul, its out-stand-ing preach-er, Pe-ter, who established the early




Church from the rem-nant of Is-ra-el, Paul, master and teacher



of the Gen-tiles that you call. And so, each in a different way




gathered together the one fam-i-ly of Christ; and revered togeth-
