

Jesus, the Way to the Father




V. The Lord be with you. R. And with your spir-it.




V. Lift up your hearts. R. We lift them up to the Lord.




V. Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. R. It is right and just.




It is truly right and just, our duty and our sal-va-tion, al-ways and




everywhere to give you thanks, ho-ly Father, Lord of heav-en and



earth, through Christ our Lord. For by your Word you cre-at-ed




the world and you govern all things in har-mo-ny. You gave us




the same Word made flesh as Mediator, and he has spoken your
